What is a portfolio?

A portfolio is a collection of the work you will complete throughout high school (we call these "artifacts"). The goal is that your portfolio will show your growth from 9th-12th grade and be an indication when you graduate that you are college and career ready. As West Adams, each student will create a digital portfolio, which will be a personal website.

STEP 1: View sample portfolio website.

STEP 2: Start your website.

- 1. Go to Google Sites (sites.google.com)
- 2. Click on "New Google Sites**オ**"
- 3. Click on red (+) button on bottom right corner ("Create new site")

STEP 3: Create your web address.

- 1. Click on purple "Publish" button near top right corner
- 2. Type in what you want your url to be. *Recommended your first name and last name* Ex: https://sites.google.com/mymail.lausd.net/_____
- 3. Click "Publish"
